13.1 A student who has successfully completed the IB Diploma Programme (IBDP) and who has achieved a minimum grade of 24 in the IBDP, and who has also achieved a minimum grade of 5 in each of the six subjects, shall be eligible for the award of the IB Diploma.

- CAS shall be completed in accordance with the requirements of the IBDP.
  - The student shall have achieved a minimum grade of 24 in the IBDP, and shall have achieved a minimum grade of 5 in each of the six subjects.
